

Episode 6 Transcript Speaker 1:

Hello and welcome to episode six of Vaccines Revealed. Today is a very special day. I have part two of my interview with Dr. Brian Hooker and this interview is a mind blower when you look at what happened within the CDC and what he discovered. If you saw part one you know exactly what I'm talking about. It's an especially banner day because today it's here: the worldwide premier of the movie Vaccine Syndrome.

This movie must be seen, especially for anybody who cares about our military, or is in the military, or knows someone in the military, as well as first responders and other people that might be affected by the anthrax vaccine. Academy Aware nominated filmmaker, Scott Miller, brings you this film with his wife, Melissa Miller, and I have to tell you it is riveting, so enjoy today's episode and enjoy that movie. In 2014, you start having phone conversations with Dr. William Thompson of the CDC.

Brian Hooker: That is correct.

Speaker 1: Give me the lead up to that. How did those communications

start? Because you had been in communication with him since

the early 2000s, right?

Brian Hooker: That is correct.

Speaker 1: Then what happened that got him to get on the phone with

you?

Brian Hooker: As a part of the lawsuits some documents surfaced that

showed in the background Dr. William Thompson talking to CDC attorneys and actually attorneys who are fighting against my son in vaccine court. They were having these conversations behind the scenes as early as 2003 and 2004. To this day I have no clue why Dr. Thompson would be talking about my son's

particular vaccine injury case. I emailed him. I was furious and I didn't care if the CDC said that I couldn't email CDC scientists.

I looked up his email address and started emailing him saying, "How could you talk about my son's case behind his back? How could you use that in order to curtail my conversations with CDC scientists? How could you use that against me?" I think I wore him down because lo and behold ... You know, I probably sent him three of four emails over the period of three or four months and then in November of 2013, I receive a phone call, I look down, it's a 404 area code. It's the CDC. I'd received harassing calls from the CDC Foy Office before and anonymous phone calls from the CDC before. I knew not to pick up the phone. I didn't want to deal with what could be at the other end of the line, but my curiosity got the best of me and I did a reverse phone lookup and lo and behold it was Dr. William Thompson.

Speaker 1: What happened when you go on the phone? What did he say?

Brian Hooker: We actually had a very, very polite conversation. One of the

first things he asked was about my son and how my son was doing. He was almost apologetic in tone. This was somebody that was very, very different than the phone conversations that I had had with him back in 2003/2004. He was a different man. He was a changed man and I could tell that right away just by sort of conciliatory tone. It took about two phone conversations for him to say, "You know, I know you're looking for information. I know you want to get into the central repository of vaccine safety data from the CDC, you're going

about it all the wrong ways. Here's what you do."

Speaker 1: He wanted to help you.

Brian Hooker: He wanted to help me get data sets so somebody on the

outside could independently analyze the data sets and see first

hand the flaws of the CDC.

Speaker 1:

Basically he knew that there was something wrong with the way they were analyzing the data and he knew that you were looking to try to get that data to analyze it independently of the CDC, but he also knew that you weren't going about it the right way and he was giving you guidance.

Brian Hooker:

That is correct. Very, very quickly he showed me how to submit at release for a public data set and by law, CDC when they use federal funds to do a vaccine study they have to come up with a public data set that the general public, primarily scientists on the outside, can have access to and through his guidance by January of 2014 I was swimming in data that I never knew existed.

Speaker 1:

Wow. What motivated him? What did he see from the inside that made him want to help guide you from the outside?

Brian Hooker:

He was motivated ... This came out December 2013/January 2014 time frame. He knew that the CDC was doing bad statistics. He knew and he was telling me that the CDC was actually lying about the relationship between vaccines and autism.

Speaker 1:

Wait. You used the word lying, like in other words they knowingly were lying about what data they're reporting relative to vaccines and autism.

Brian Hooker:

Right. He knew that not only ... It started out a little more innocuous and he was talking about the flaws in the methodology that the CDC was using. Then all of the sudden the conversation turned on a dime and we were talking about fraud.

Speaker 1:

Wow. Do you think his conscience got to him? What do you think happened?

Brian Hooker:

I think that this is something that had been brewing in his conscience since 2004, Since when he saw just very, very

specific blatant fraud by his superiors at the CDC and this is what he was reporting to me. He wanted to make sure that somebody on the outside knew that this fraud had taken place.

Speaker 1:

Wow.

Brian Hooker:

The way that he wanted to go about doing that was to give me the data and for me to publish the results in peer reviewed scientific literature that showed, yes, there is a relationship. When we started out with the MMR vaccine, which I undertook in trepidation because I was not an expert at that time regarding the MMR, but we started out with a study that was fraudulent and flawed that he did in 2004 and he said, "I want you to reanalyze that data set."

Speaker 1:

Just to get clear-

Yeah.

Speaker 1:

Because this is very dramatic, a research scientist at the CDC who's involved in the autism study in MMR, autism relationship, which was one of the prime studies to debunk the relationship ... Because Andy Wakefield was completely discredited over his minor assertion in the beginning that there might be a relationship here and then everybody who says, "Oh, it's been disproven that there's a relationship between the two, the CDC study, et cetera," this was something that was a milestone study and the guy who was on the research project contacts you and says, "Please get this information and reanalyze it."

Brian Hooker:

That is correct. He was the lead statistician on this particular study. The first author of the study was Frank DeStefano who was and still is the head of the Immunization Safety Office at CDC. One of the authors was Colleen Boil, who is pretty much second in command at the CDC. She's a head of one of the major centers, The National Center for Birth Defects and Developmental Disabilities. Another chief researcher,

[inaudible 00:07:56], and then a post doc who was just on loan from her university. The five of the colluded to coverup the results, several different alarming results, that showed when you get the MMR on time you are indeed more susceptible and more likely to get an autism diagnosis than when you delay it until after three years of age.

Speaker 1:

Wow. Again, strong words. Colluded. Did Thompson talk about this collusion that these people got together and eliminated data from the study to make it appear a certain way?

Brian Hooker:

He would talk about it in rather vague terms but he did use the word collude and he used very, very strong language to say that the data that were published were completely fraudulent, that they had embarked upon a study and he started to share documentation; documentation of how the study was suppose to be done in the first place and then he guided me through the steps on how they deviated from that plan because they saw relationships between the MMR and autism and they did not want to publish them.

Speaker 1:

The hair on the back of my neck is literally standing up right now. Incidentally you've had numerous conversations with him, four which were recorded so that you have documentary evidence to say, "These conversations are real."

Brian Hooker:

That's correct.

Speaker 1:

It's validated that these things were said and many more things that weren't recorded, but the point is though here you are, the parent of an autistic child who has the course of your entire life altered because of the vaccines that you're child was given and you're on the phone now with a research scientist from the CDC who publishes with other co-authors a paper, and he's the lead guy on the statistics for the paper and is basically saying that there is collusion for these authors to misrepresent the data to try to show that there was not a relationship between the MMR vaccine and autism and, yet,

the reality is if you look at the data they had there is. Now you're seeing not only how are you affected but because of the collusion how many other families out there are sitting there with autistic kids because this information was never represented properly or truthfully.

Brian Hooker:

The CDC knew about these relationships as early as November seventh, 2001 because I have the memo that says November seventh 2001 and it delineates these relationships and it shows a positive relationship with the MMR and autism among African-Americans. It showed an association with what the CDC termed isolated autism; that's kids like my son that have got autism but didn't have any other types of [inaudible 00:10:59] morbidities like cerebral palsy or mental retardation. It just basically regressed into autism.

There were strong, statistically significant relationships. The CDC knew about it November seventh, 2001 and you look at how many kids have been born since then, how many kids have been diagnosed with autism since then, and how many kids actually got the MMR on time, and how many lives, how many families could have been saved.

Speaker 1:

In your wildest dreams do you think you could have ever gotten to the point where you're only the phone [inaudible 00:11:32] with a CDC scientist who's on the autism study with MMR calling you and talking to you and basically saying, "Reanalyze this data please." Saying there's collusion between the scientists, that there's fraud in the way that they're representing the data, that you are a family that's affected. You know in 2001 you already reviewed that they were hiding things. I think you said November seventh, 2001 that there was email traffic that you go through [inaudible 00:12:02]. All these years, all these kids getting vaccinated. Now, one of the things that I have no ... Because I've had conversations with you personally and I've watched [inaudible 00:12:10]. One of the things is that what they showed in this study was that if you

delayed the use of the MMR vaccine, the risk of autism goes down precipitously, correct?

Brian Hooker: That is correct.

Speaker 1: I mean it was an obvious thing and they didn't even want to

report that. They could have just said, "Hey, we have new data.

Delay this," but it would then admit that the people who follow the schedule in the beginning have autistic kids as a result of their recommendations so they couldn't admit it.

Brian Hooker: The CDC would never go on record and admit that so they

chose to cover it up and what they did was they say on that information. For a year and a half they would meet weekly. These five scientists would meet on a weekly basis. They would have Thompson rerun the data, reanalyze the data. He could

not make the effect go away. Okay.

Speaker 1: Even trying to make the effect go away by reanalyzing the data

or using different statistical manipulation he still couldn't make

it go away.

Brian Hooker: He couldn't make that information go away and so what they

decided to do, specifically with the African-Americans was they said, "Oh, we will only rely on race data for those individuals that have a valid state of Georgia birth certificate," so it took that population and it reduced it by almost a half. It became half as large and everybody that knows statistics knows that if you have a smaller sampling size you lose statistical power, you

lose the relationship and so they use that. There was no good

reason to say that, "Oh, we got race data from birth certificates," because the race data was in all the school records for all the children that were participating in that

study. The only reason they did that was to reduce the statistical power. The scientists that were Thompson's

superiors said, "Run it this way and see what happens," and lo and behold when they eliminated those kids the relationship

went away.

Speaker 1:

Their could be no logic, right? You're saying, "I know one way we could reduce the sample size is if they don't have a Georgia birth certificate," as if that changes them genetically somehow. As if that changes their species, why should it matter what birth certificate they have to the study and the population in the study. Is their any rationale?

Brian Hooker:

There is no effective rationale for that. There is no scientific reason for that. It is clear cut that what they wanted to do is reduce the statistical power so they could make that relationship go away and when they were able to do that, Dr. Colleen Boyle and and Dr. Frank DeStefano called a meeting, said bring in all of your information regarding the effect with African-Americans and we're going to throw it away. We are going to destroy that information. I don't have the exact day that they met but it was between September and October 2002, so they'd been sitting on that data for about eight months and they decided that they would trashcan that data and if you look at the information that the CDC had after the trashcan meeting, those results were nowhere to be found. They buried them.

Speaker 1:

Whoa. Dr. Thompson, who was on the study, affirms that this shredding party, if you will, happened.

Brian Hooker:

Dr. Thompson was there at the shredding party. Interestingly enough the superior who ordered the shredding party, Dr. Colleen Boyle, decided not to attend that particular meeting. Her fingerprints were all over the meeting but she would not to do the dirty work.

Speaker 1:

Literally these scientists on this project got together, order by their superiors to get together, and said, "We want to eliminate this data and we are literally going to shred or dispose of this data so we have no record of it."

Brian Hooker:

That is correct. That is a violation of the Federal Records Act of 1950 as amended in the 1970s. They were taking federal

records. That information could be considered federal information and instead of handling it properly and archiving the federal records, they destroyed it.

Speaker 1:

When you look at the study it obviously isn't there and then they can say it's no where to be found except they didn't count on the fact that Dr. Thompson kept a copy.

Brian Hooker:

Dr. Thompson knew that he would be legally liable for destroying that information so he retained his own copy of not only the hard copies, but he also had the electronic copies on the hard drive of his computer and that's ultimately what he shared with me.

Speaker 1:

Wow. This is kind of a pretty damning situation for these CDC officials because, if I understand correctly, Congressman Posey in Florida has a copy of this in a safe and they're trying to call Dr. Thompson as a whistleblower to appear in front of congress and talk about this fraud and deception.

Brian Hooker:

That is correct. During conversations that we had I wanted Dr. Thompson to do two things. I wanted him to hire a whistleblower attorney a declare federal whistleblower status so he had the protections that were afforded by that particular status. He did that. He ended up getting one of the top whistleblower attorneys in the country in order to represent himself.

The second thing that I wanted him to do was to reach out to Congressman Bill Posey. Bill Posey has been sympathetic regarding the autism vaccine issue since he took office, I believe, in 2012. When he took office, when he took over, he was a friend of our community and Dr. Thompson then went to him with large bins of information; physically took bins of information to Bill Posey's office, set those down, and shared all of the records that he had shared with me up to that point in time. We're talking about tens of thousands of pages of documents-

Speaker 1: Wow.

Brian Hooker: That showed CDC fraud, that showed CDC inclination that

when they found a positive relationship, that showed a tie between a vaccine or vaccine component and autism, that they would either bury the relationship entirely by throwing it in the trashcan or they would downplay the relationship and make sure that the final publication had verbiage that said there's nothing to worry about, there's nothing to worry about the MMR, there's nothing to worry about [inaudible 00:18:52] so, indeed, instead of changing the vaccine schedule to err on the side of safety, they changed the vaccine schedule to err on the side of more profits for the pharmaceutical companies and

themselves acting as a vaccine company.

Speaker 1: Wow. I'm basically speechless. I can't imagine what's going on

inside of your mind because you're wearing all these hats. First of all, you're like the investigator who's discovering all of this. You have a child that's vaccine damaged. You're a research scientist yourself so you understand these things on a deep level as far as how this can be pulled off and how they can pull the wool over one's eyes. You're also cognizant of the fact that there are children damaged every single day right now because

this information is not public. What do you feel inside?

Brian Hooker: I was completely conflicted. When my head hit the pillow at

night I would think about the lives that could be saved if this information was made public. I would try to weigh that against

continuing the relationship with Thompson and other

documents that he could funnel from the CDC to me in order to bring the CDC down, which I think is still a worthy goal and is something that needs to happen. We need complete reform

in the CDC. Thompson himself told me that vaccine safety didn't belong in the CDC or in the department of health and human services as a whole. It needed to be moved out. It

needed to be an independent agency.

I weighed that affecting change in the CDC and being able to reform this so somebody somewhere could know that the CDC came clean versus how many people were diagnosed with autism today. How many people are going to be diagnosed with autism tomorrow? How many people are going to comply blindly with a bloated vaccination schedule that's a recipe for disaster, it's a grand medical experiment. It hasn't been researched properly and the research that has been done shows grave danger for people who follow that vaccination schedule. I was very, very conflicted.

I also worked early on ... It was never really palatable for me to record phone conversations with Dr. Thompson, especially without his knowledge. I did not want him to know that I was recording these conversations because I wanted him to speak honestly. I wanted him to repeat some of the things that he had said in conversations with me that I had not recorded and I also had two attorneys working with me to make sure that what I was doing was not illegal. Now, I live in California. California is a two party consent state so it is illegal to record somebody without their knowledge. I'm next door to Oregon so two of the calls that were recorded were made in Oregon. Another one of the calls was made in Virginia, which is a one party state, and then the final call was made in Illinois, which is a one party state.

I needed to protect my family. I wanted some type of proof that this happened. I wanted some type of evidence, some type of time stamp that said, "We had these conversations. This is definitively Bill Thompson revealing this information to me. This isn't me with a pile of information. This was me with a government employee who's making admissions of collusion to commit fraud by senior CDC officials," and that's why I recorded those calls.

Speaker 1:

Not only is a government employee, it's not like some admin person said, "I think something's going on in the other room over here." It's the guy in the center of it, basically. He's one of

the guys on the study but here's the thing: out in the world when you mention autism and vaccines, "Oh, that's been disproven." They look at you like you're some kind of an idiot. "Oh, that's been refuted, that's been scientifically proven," so now people are lining up saying, "I don't have to worry about this. That's all been disproven," because of what's been put out.

They're vaccinating these kids and, literally, even if you decided that you wanted to vaccinate, which is probably based on everything that we know not a good idea, but even if you decided, "You know what? I want to do it." Literally if they just report the data and they delayed the administration of the MMR vaccine, that would reduce the risk you're taking by a lot according to the data that that study originally gathered.

Brian Hooker: That is correct. If you look at the original data ... I did the

analysis. I did the analysis in January and February of 2014. I saw that the risk for African-American males that received the MMR on time was three times greater than African-American

males that got the MMR after three years of-

Speaker 1: Three times greater?

Brian Hooker: Three times greater. There was three times as much autism.

Speaker 1: It's not like a 15 or 20 ... Three times more likely to get autism

if they vaccinated before 36 months as compared to after?

Brian Hooker: That is correct. That is correct.

Speaker 1: In the African-American population.

Brian Hooker: That is correct.

Speaker 1: Wow. Now you look at saying ... That's what they said, "We're

going to bury that data. We're going to dispose of that data.

We're not reporting it at all," but it's in the original ...

Brian Hooker: It's in the original study.

Speaker 1: Yeah.

Brian Hooker: It's in their data and I attempted to publish that information. I

had a publication accepted in the journal Translational Neurodegeneration, it's a journal that I had published in

before. We went through peer review. The article appeared in print at the end of July of 2014. Lo and behold, when the entire whistleblower story broke, and this broke around August 21, 2014, it took about four days and the journal took my paper down from the website so it was no longer ... At first they said

that-

Speaker 1: Did they fully retract it or they just don't put it up?

Brian Hooker: They published a statement. They took the paper completely

down. They published a statement saying that the results of this paper would have a negative affect on public health.

Speaker 1: The truth has a negative affect on public health and we can't

let that happen?

Brian Hooker: We can't let that happen. About 24 hours later they instead

changed that and said that I had undisclosed conflict of

interest which was rubbish, which was completely fabricated.

It was a lie.

Speaker 1: What's your conflict of interest? What monetary gain do you

get by publishing this data? What I'm hearing is they never said

that your statistical analysis was wrong.

Brian Hooker: No.

Speaker 1: They basically were trying to find other way ... Through peer

review they said this was properly done.

Brian Hooker: Right.

Speaker 1: They're looking for a different angle to try to discredit the

paper.

Brian Hooker: Ultimately the paper was put ... I like to call it time out because

kids get time out and they have to go sit in the time out chair.

My paper was put in time out of for about six weeks and

during those six weeks I argued back and forth with the journal regarding why it should be published, why my science was sound. They sent me back a paragraph description from one of

their editors saying that my science was unacceptable. I rebutted that paragraph. They never sent a response to that and then on October third they completely retracted the

paper.

Speaker 1: Of course no coincidence that when the whistleblower story

comes out, that within the temporal profile of that that's when

your paper gets retracted.

Brian Hooker: That's when my paper gets retracted.

Speaker 1: That's just a coincidence I'm sure.

Brian Hooker: Exactly. Yeah. Yeah.

Speaker 1: Because your science was fine when they published it. Wow.

My God. How do you control the outreach and how do you not let it beat you up inside? I mean, it's really almost unthinkable.

Brian Hooker: It is a very, very difficult response to be able to let things like

that go. It was a difficult step for me to forgive Thompson. I mean, in the first place. I felt like he alone, by sitting on this as long as he did, is culpable for a large amount of damage to society. There are a lot of families that have been shattered. I

really did have to let it go and my wife, Marsha, was

instrumental in that, "You know what? You need to let this whole thing go." Getting my paper retracted ... I never got detention in school. I've never had anything big like that

happen. I've never had a paper retracted. Having that was a real psychological blow to me.

I just had to let it go but the silver lining was I was contracted by several scientists that said, "Look, we know what you've gone through. We want you to republish that data because that data needs to be on the public domain. They've provided an opportunity ... This whole paper will be republished, actually in a much more expanded form, and laying out the logic of why my results are correct and why the paper should have never been retracted in the first place. It's coming out in a book in, I believe, in fall of 2017 that's published by [inaudible 00:28:28] Scientific, a very reputable publishing house.

Speaker 1: Very reputable. I know who they are. Sure.

Brian Hooker: I've had my day in the public domain. I will have my day in the

public domain. I count myself worth of some of the scars that

were endured by great people like Andy Wakefield.

Speaker 1: Okay with you.

Speaker 3: Sir, I am here for the sake of my client, Corporal Jared

Schwartz, who would like to be heard, sir, and I believe that he

deserves to be heard.

Speaker 4: You heard our ruling on this, ruling is final.

Speaker 3: Ladies and gentleman, this is a very young man. 20 years of

age. Sir, this young man signed up at 17.

Speaker 4: An order is an order. If that's not consistent then we lose.

Speaker 3: Sir, it wouldn't hurt your military code if you just listened to his

reason for not observing the direct order. President Clinton

passed some legislation and it-

Speaker 5: Put it away.

Speaker 3: Yes, sir. Sir, armed with what you can get on the internet today

would you have taken the vaccine, sir?

Speaker 6: Fuck the internet.

Speaker 4: Listen, I'm going to cut this short. We will hear him. You

understand that?

Speaker 3: Yes, I do, sir.

Speaker 4: I don't think you do!

Speaker 8: General!

Speaker 4: I don't think you do!

Speaker 8: General, knock it off!

Speaker 4: You pissed me off, counsellor, we will hear him. We will hear

him. Do you understand that? We will not comment on the

record. Do we understand each other.

Speaker 3: Yes, sir.

Speaker 4: Okay, counsellor. Conversations over.

Speaker 3: Yes, sir. They are going to let you speak. You've got the speech.

Have you read it?

Jared Schwartz: Yes, sir, but my mom doesn't want me to say anything. She

wants it all to go away, sir.

Speaker 3: What do you want?

Jared Schwartz: I want to sever my country, be a Marine, sir.

Speaker 3: I believe you'll be able to fight for your country again.

Jared Schwartz: They going to let me speak on the record, sir?

Speaker 3: Yes, they are, but I won't be in there with you. I think they

know that the vaccine has problems. Take your time. Don't worry how it all sounds. We want it all recorded for the

transcript.

Jared Schwartz: I will not let us down, sir.

Speaker 10: The first trial for refusing the direct order to take the Anthrax

vaccine took place three months before President Clinton signed executive order 13139. It lasted only three hours because a defense attorney, Mark Zaid, was not allowed to

present any witnesses or evidence. What follows is a

reenactment of the sworn statement of Lance Corporal Jared

Schwartz given at his sentencing hearing.

Jared Schwartz: Corporal Schwartz reporting to the senior member of the

board, sir.

Speaker 4: Corporal Schwartz, even though you've been found guilty of

disobeying a lawful order, I have personally decided to allow you to speak to your superiors. Do you understand that?

Jared Schwartz: Yes, sir. Your honor, having been found guilty of the offense of

disobeying a lawful order to take the anthrax vaccine, I stand before you willing to accept my punishment. Before I do, I believe it is important that you find out who I am and why I chose to refuse what I still consider an unlawful order. I am now 20 years old and I grew up in Henderson, Kentucky. I chose to join the Marine Corps because it was the hardest

challenge I knew of, and I thought it would help develop myself into a better person for the future. I enlisted when I was 18 years old for a five year tour. I never thought that I would not

complete my full tour.

I have never had any disciplinary problems while a Marine and I've never been in any kind of trouble before that. I was a good

Marine. I stand here today representing ever member of this service who wishes to challenge the Anthrax vaccine program. If my actions may lead to a change in what has been deemed a decision of policy, then my personal sacrifice will have been worth it. I want to thank God, and my family, and my friends for the support that they have provided throughout this whole ordeal. Thank you.

Speaker 4: Corporal Schwartz, you're dismissed.

Jared Schwartz: Aye, aye, sir.

Speaker 10: The sentence was 30 days in the brig and a bad conduct

discharge. Today, Lance Corporal Jared Schwartz is a convicted

felon.

Speaker 11: The film you're about to see is a true story. Why is this

executive order given by a civilian President who never served a day in his life in the military still enforced today? They say that 35,000 military members are receiving the vaccine a month. They say that no one is ill from the vaccine. They say that the vaccine is safe, effective, and FDA approved. They say all three point two million members are to receive the vaccine. I am proud to be an American. I believe this vaccine is unsafe. I believe that we should have the right to control our own body.

Speaker 12: In the only public study ever done it was found that 30 percent

of vaccinated members of the military have reported some chronic illnesses they claim are due to the Anthrax vaccine. These symptoms have become known as Gulf War Syndrome.

Speaker 13: I was alone and I eventually become so sick. I was having

problems with memory lapses and I couldn't remember things. I couldn't remember hours. I couldn't remember what I did for an entire day. I couldn't drive at times. I wasn't eating. I was

down to chicken broth and saltines if I was lucky. The

immunology clinic at Walter Reed wrote it down that I had problems with the Anthrax vaccination. You're a broke soldier.

You're sick. You don't like broke things so we're going to throw that out and replace it with a new number.

Speaker 12:

There are many desperately anxious to tell their stories so their comrades may be spared. If we ignore this perhaps we are all guilty of terrorism.

Speaker 14:

It baffles me that people, the ill people, are not being heard. Again, they go through the old saying that was used was, "If people are malingerous liars and whiners, oh, they're air crew members, they're fliers. They've got egos a mile long and they're just whining. They don't want to fly." I find that offensive.

Earl Stauffer:

My name is Earl Stauffer, I'm a tech sergeant E6, 326 [inaudible 00:40:36] Squadron at Dover Air Force base. I'm a load master on the C5s. Received the Anthrax vaccine January/February. That changed it all. A couple of months after my third Anthrax vaccine. I was sitting on my sofa one Sunday morning, enjoying life, windows open. I live on a farm; sunshine, blue skies. Next thing I know I'm heading for the floor. Me, coffee cup, everything. About 30 to 45 minutes later I was able to crawl to the bottom of the stairs in my farm house and get my wife's attention to tell her something was wrong when she came downstairs. That lasted for about six hours that day. The bad thing of it is it started happening every other day. We're going on 40 some odd months now, nonstop, 24/7, screaming in my ears.

Rhonda Wilson:

My name is Rhonda Lynn Wilson and I'm 26 years old. I was a CW2 in the Army. Our PT scores are the highest of 300 and I was maxing out on my physical training. I was the only female pilot in the calvary where I was stationed so I kind of stood out a bit. I took three. You eat something and within ten minutes I'm in the fetal position crying and crying in pain because of the cramping, and the nausea, and the vomiting, and that goes anywhere from a half hour up to a couple hours. I guess I was naive thinking that they would never harm soldiers because I

was a soldier first, and then an officer, and then an aviator, and even though aviation was my love the military was my life. Nobody can help me but maybe I could help someone.

Speaker 11:

Mandatory vaccination of the two point five military members, members of the Coast Guard, and some civilian employees began in March 1998 with the very public inoculation of Secretary of Defense, William Cohen.

William Cohen:

It's important when we talk about weapons of mass destruction that we translate that into something that the American people and hopefully the world community can understand. For example, we talk about Anthrax. If you took a five pound bag of sugar and except call this Anthrax. This amount of Anthrax could be spread over a city, let's say, the size of Washington. It would destroy at least half the population of that city. One of the things we found with Anthrax is that one breath and you are likely to face death within five days. One small particle of Anthrax will produce death within five days.

Speaker 11:

There were to be six shots over an 18 month period with an annual booster shot but within weeks soldiers were reporting adverse reactions and refusing additional doses. The vaccine was not FDA approved and neither was the protocol for giving it. The FDA cited the lab producing the vaccine for almost 100 violations including substandard record keeping. Soldiers who refused the shot were subject to disciplinary actions. It was concocted with up to 100 times the antigen levels of the original vaccine. It had been combined with irritants such as the agitant squalene and other pathogens because the vaccine did not result in a satisfactory immune response to Anthrax.

Israel gave 26 million dollars to USAMRIID to oversea a joint Anthrax program code named OMER 2. USAMRIID's Dr. Ivans, who ran the project, knew in 1998, the same year that the US program started, that the Anthrax vaccine had seriously injured 1500 Israeli Defense Force Soldiers. February 2014, 96

Israeli soldiers were awarded six million dollars for damage causes in 1998 by the American Anthrax vaccine.

Earl Stauffer:

Friendly fire. Friendly fire through a needle.

Speaker 12:

People suffering from Gulf War Syndrome have reported the following symptoms: blackouts, chronic fatigue, cysts on the scalp; lesions on the brain, heart, and lungs; the inability to concentrate, respiratory problems, skin rashes, vertigo, autoimmune disorders, chronic headaches, thyroid cancer, paralysis of the stomach, allergies, liver damage, turrets syndrome, and more.

Speaker 11:

The National Vaccine Injury Compensation Program was enacted by congress so that manufacturers would be held harmless for lawsuits from injuries due to rapidly developed, possibly unsafe vaccines. If you are injured by a vaccine you must sue the US government, not the manufacturer or their profits. The Vaccine Injury Compensation Program is not available to military personnel.

Lt. Rich:

For every one individual that comes forward there are three individuals that will not.

Speaker 20:

Lieutenant Rich [inaudible 00:46:58] is a male nurse with 17 years in the service. He has medically treated many members of the service who are suffering from various symptoms of the Gulf War Syndrome. On 21 July 1999, Lieutenant [inaudible 00:47:09] went to Washington and because of his rank he was allowed to speak to a congressional committee on behalf of his fellow members of the military. By doing so he risked his standing in the military community.

Lt. Rich:

After I testified I said I said my career began to take a steady nosedive. I was viewed with suspicion and, in some circles, ostracized. There was a time when I was pulled out of the clinic to work on a flu shot line as a skilled qualified lieutenant. I had no problem performing an extra duty if it was for the good of

the mission, but I was taken from my clinic duties, removed from my clinic duties, and was to administer flu shots per 20 some odd days. At that point I said, "Oh, boy." I says, "This is getting rough here," but I when ahead [inaudible 00:48:00] and pressed on. Then I found out that they had brought out the Anthrax vaccine and even though I did not have to give it, the vaccine was still going to be administered on the flu shot line.

I had some concerns and I said, "If we're administering this vaccine which is currently controversial," and you always say the controversial Anthrax vaccine. We're giving this controversial vaccine. We should be trying to collect going data on people that are receiving it. We were giving multiple vaccinations, including those who were due for their Anthrax vaccine on a flu shot line. How in the world can you determine if a vaccine had caused an illness or an adverse reaction when you're giving it co-commitently with other vaccines?

Speaker 21:

We were also ordered, "Do not record lots, batches, doses, who got them, what their reactions were, when the got them, or how many they got." Direct orders.

Speaker 12:

These people suffer from Gulf War Syndrome. The military tells us it's an emotional ailment. We do know that the vaccine given then was not approved by the FDA. We do know that refusal to take the shots has resulted in dishonorable discharge, fines, and prison. We do know that mandatory Anthrax vaccinations are to continue.

Speaker 11:

One out of three returning veterans, including those that had not seen combat, required treatment for depression and posttraumatic stress syndrome. For more than 3,000 years rulers have used germ warfare to gain an unseen advantage over their opponents, but unseen is also uncontrollable. There can be unintended consequences. One of the world's most notorious acts killed off half the population in Europe in the 14th Century. Bubonic plague victims were thrown over city

walls. Fleas from the corpses infected rats and it spread from there. Black death claimed 25 million lives.

In 1876, German physician Robert Koch isolated Anthrax spores from diseased animals. He proved that a disease is caused by a particular organism. Imperial Germany used Anthrax as a weapon in World War One, 1914 to 1918. This prompted world leaders to sign the Geneva Protocol in 1925 to ban the use of chemical and bacteriological methods of warfare. It did not prevent countries from researching, developing, and producing these weapons. During and after World War Two, the United States, Great Britain, and other countries developed Anthrax weapons.

Lynn Schroeder:

They are incidents of empire and power. Military power. Human experimentation comes out of that inevitably. It always will because people don't matter.

Speaker 11:

Attorney Lynn Schroeder won thousands of agent orange cases against the government for Vietnam vets. During World War Two the Allied Forces and the Axis Powers openly developed nuclear weapons but their biological and chemical weapons programs were conducted in secret.

Speaker 20:

In the summer of 1944 the British Primer Minister, Winston Churchill, approved an order of 500,000 four pound Anthrax bombs to be built in the united states. The war ended before the order was completed. With the extent of the program conducted by the Japanese was staggering. Unit 731, in existence since 1933, was staffed with over 3,000 scientists and technicians secretly experimenting on Manchurian prisoners.

Speaker 23:

Dr. Shirō Ishii, head of Unit 731, sunk so low as to hand out candy to starving Chinese children; chocolates that were laced with Anthrax, a highly lethal disease that attacks the respiratory and digestive systems.

Speaker 20:

In exchange for immunity from prosecution for war crimes, the directs of Unit 731 one were interrogated by the Americans. They revealed that hundreds of thousands had died. 11 Chinese cities were attacked with biological agents, including Anthrax cultures sprayed from aircraft. 1700 Japanese soldiers died in one attack alone. One disadvantage of bio-weapons should have been very clear: the difficulty of protecting one's own troops and citizens.

Speaker 11:

The lead scientist of the notorious Unit 731, Dr. Ishii was enlisted by Henry Stimson to conduct biohazard experiments at Fort Detrick. The program expanded to over 100 locations in America.

Speaker 24:

Volunteers are important to the testing picture. For many years information has been needed on the effect of a biological warfare attack on man. The volunteers were a picked group. They had received psychiatric interviews to determine their maturity and reliability as well as mental output. Any history of a chronic disease, any allergic reaction or nervous disorder was a cause for rejection. Volunteers were given the opportunity to drop out at any time. The volunteers had been positioned in cubicles on the outside of the test sphere.

A hollow steel ball, forty feet in diameter in which a cloud of biological warfare agent can be generated. Through a series of controllable panels and a face mask, it was possible to expose a person in each cubicle to a measured volume of biological aerosol from the sphere. Research has lead to many scientific findings beneficial to mankind such as a perfected vaccine for controlling industrial Anthrax, a usually fatal disease of cattle and sheep.

Speaker 20:

In 1953, researchers turned their attention to vaccines, antisera, and therapeutic agents. They must have realized too late that it is much easier to create an antibiotic resistant strain of a pathogen than it is to create an immunity to it.

Lynn Schroeder: I know how emotionally, intellectually, and in ever other way

the horror of human experimentation. Unfortunately human experimentation continues, continues to this day, and is done largely by governments including the United States right now.

Speaker 25: One of the biological agents Iraq is suspected of hiding is the

deadly Anthrax virus. The United States military announced Monday it will vaccinate nearly all of it's active and reserve troops against Anthrax to prepare for the possibility of germ

warfare.

Speaker 11: President Clinton's executive order 13139 created a mandatory

Anthrax vaccination immunization program. This direct order made it illegal for military members to refuse experimental

vaccines or drugs.

Speaker 26: I could foresee were an executive order, "We need to go do

this because of this and we need to do it now. We don't have

time for debate." I can see that possibility.

George W. Bush: The Iraqi Regime has plotted to develop Anthrax. This is a

regime that has already used poison gas to murder thousands of it's own citizens, leaving the bodies of mothers huddled over their dead children. The biggest regret of all the presidency has

to have been the intelligence failure in Iraq. It wasn't just

people in my administration-

Speaker 29: His biggest regret is that he had incorrect information related

to Saddam Hussein and weapons of mass destruction.

Speaker 11: It seems that successive Presidents fail to scrutinize executive

orders. President Bush did not repeal 13139 before he left

office in January 2009.

Speaker 30: I know that we can.

Barak Obama: Those who tell us that we can't, we will respond with that

timeless creed that sums up the spirit of the people: yes we

can. Thank you. God bless you and may God bless the United States of America.

Speaker 11: President Obama was reelected but military voting had

dropped 70 percent in the 2012 election.

Michelle Obama: I have seen first hand that being President doesn't change who

you are.

Barak Obama: The truth gets buried under an avalanche of money.

Speaker 33: [inaudible 00:57:17].

Barak Obama: We will serve our veterans as well as they've served us.

Speaker 34: I think these questions need to be asked.

Ray Bristo: I've got nowhere.

Speaker 34: More important, they need to be answered.

Ray Bristo: Around me private parts.

Speaker 36: We have tried to do this to the best of our ability.

Ray Bristo: I haven't been given a reason why. [inaudible 00:57:36].

Earl Stauffer: I'd rather have caught a bullet from an AK-47 than be injected

with this stuff.

Speaker 37: These changes did not happen over night.

Speaker 11: Despite congressional findings, independent research, and

veteran association warnings that spanned 20 years, President Obama is expanding the Anthrax vaccine program. Over one million soldiers in the United States suffer from Gulf War illness due to the Anthrax vaccine. The first Gulf War was the most toxic war in history. Gulf War Syndrome were caused by six main toxicities; oil and gas fumes from the oil field fires, sarin gas released when allied troops blew up Iraqi munitions

sites, fine radioactive particle dust from spent Uranium weapons, pesticides and repellents used against insects and flies, experimental drugs intended to protect against nerve agents, and the Anthrax vaccine. Speaker 38: They worry that the real enemy was the vaccine itself.

Speaker 39: If it's your very first Anthrax shot, raise your hand.

Michelle Obama: I've seen it in people who become heroes at a moments

Speaker 11: Military women, after receiving the vaccine are being advised

not to become pregnant during the 18 month period of six Anthrax shots. This is due to reported pregnancy problems and

birth defects.

Malcolm Hooper: There must be something wrong when you've got veterans

coming forward who don't want to believe they're ill who are ill and seeing the effects of the inoculations from the Gulf War. My name is Malcolm Hooper. I'm the Emeritus professor of medicinal chemistry at the University of Sunderland and the chief advisor to the Gulf War veterans in the UK. I assumed that they would just want to talk to me occasionally about things like some things in their medical records. This turned

out not to be the case.

They put me on these government committees as their representative and I've been very active every since 97 with

the affairs with the Gulf War veterans. When I talk to Gulf War veterans, and to Gulf War veterans wives and partners, they are almost unanimous in saying that this is part of the difficulties of their relationships. That when they made love they entered a world of pain and pain in the most intimate parts of their bodies. It's just another factor that needs to be looked at carefully and it hasn't been looked at carefully.

It's been dismissed because someone's looked in some record and found little mention of it. It's not the sort of thing that Gulf War veterans, and particularly men, go around chanting out and telling everybody. The National Gulf War Veterans and Families Association, the families [inaudible 01:01:57] which where the ladies have talked to each other and they've talked about this thing as being part of the difficulties they have in their relationships. Burning semen syndrome, it's painful, it's destructive, and it's frightening because we don't know what it means and what it adds up to. If you have a baby born as a result of a partner who has burning semen syndrome what's the impact of that? We don't know, but we do know we are seeing babies who are seriously damaged.

Sammy R. Young: The name is Sammy R. Young, Y-O-U-N-G. I'm a retired Air Force Reserve Medical Service Corp colonel and I'm a retired former investigator and regulatory official with the US Food and Drug Administration where I served for 29 years and two months. Knowing what I know about the approval of the product, I would not take it. I would not accept the vaccine because it had never been approved for the use for which the Department of Defense intended to use it, namely inhalation Anthrax. This is not just a military situation, this bodes evil for the American public.

Malcolm Hooper: The regimen for giving the vaccines was not adhered to. A lot of people received a lot of vaccines in a very short period of time. I think this is of great concern because this is not recommended practice for the administration of vaccines.

The Anthrax vaccine, it cannot go on. My first Anthrax vaccine caused me to feel ill and have flu-like symptoms. I felt nauseated and then two weeks later we needed to have our second Anthrax vaccine. I stood in line to have that and they asked if anyone felt sick from their first Anthrax vaccine. I stood in the line for people who felt like they were sick from the first one. I would have been court marshaled if I had not stood in line. One of the symptoms has caused me to have a form of turrets syndrome. It caused fibromyalgia, chronic fatigue syndrome. Sensitivity to Anthrax vaccine is what they put.

I have chronic pain. I was on a drug called ... One of the drugs right away I was put on was Neurontin, Vicodin. At one time for pain I was taking 12 Vicodin a day. I'm down to about right Vicodin a day, between six and eight Vicodin a day. I had 14 years and I believe seven months of service. I can't work. There was no way that I could put in another, what is it, six years. I have a bad attitude about how they expected a fifth grader to take care of her mother. I don't know if it was necessarily one person, or a lot of people, or the decision makers who came up with the mandatory reasoning for having us take the Anthrax vaccine.

Speaker 43:

Three and a half weeks after her sixth shot she pretty much out of the blue wakes up one morning and she's on her period and it's pouring right out of her, just pouring. She goes to the clinic there on the base and figure it's something else, she might have some virus or something, and they have her sitting in the waiting area while ... You know how ERs are when you take care of the priority cases first and so she was sitting out there. At the time they didn't ... Without knowing, they didn't know it, she was dying. Kenzie is convinced to this day that her mom passed away because she cut her finger because that's what she remembers. She remembers being home with her mom and that happening.

Speaker 44:

A lot of other people got the Anthrax but I just want to know why it affected him that way. He was 19 and I was 18. We were hanging Christmas lights and he was wearing my favorite sweatshirt and the roof, it's like a brown red and he had got it all dirty, and I told him that he had ruined my sweatshirt. He was joking around how he'll make it up to me and then we were just talking and he went quiet, just like a daze, and ... Because we were fooling around on the roof to be honest but there's really no way to tell you this story without throwing that in there.

Anyway, then he got really quiet and I looked at him and he tried to say something to me. He was kind of sitting on his knees, and he just had this glossy look, and he was just looking right past me, pretty much through me, and I told him to quit messing around. He just went limp. I was like, "Quit messing around. It's not funny. Don't play like that." Because I teach CPR and he's always pretending in the pool that he's drowning so I'd have to save him. I thought he was playing and he wasn't. He was falling back and I caught him. I laid him down and ... I didn't recognize that he needed CPR at the time. I just started counting on the roof.

Speaker 11:

An autopsy revealed Sergeant Dan Cole died from a major heart attack due to massive lesions on his main arteries. Sergeant Rodriguez received the Anthrax vaccine prior to deploying to Iraq in 2007. Vaccines stress the immune system and weaken it's ability to fight existing conditions of disease.

Barak Obama:

To days when depression, PTSD were stigmatized, those days must end. That's why I made the decision to start sending condolence letters to the families of service members who take their lives while deployed in a combat zone.

Speaker 11:

The families of service members who commit suicide while deployed are not entitled to funeral expenses or benefits.

Ray Bristo:

It was three Anthrax, two [inaudible 01:10:52], and they asked what the biological injections were and they said that they was Anthrax, [inaudible 01:11:04] ready mixed so in that case I've then had a total of five Anthrax injections. I've got reduce perfusion to the cortex of the brain and [inaudible 01:11:21] in the cerebral parietal lobes and the brain stem. I have recall problems, memory loss, intimate and dyslexia difficulty in reading and retaining the information; poor coordination, and I've got loss of peripheral vision, I suffer from double vision.

I've got tinnitus, loss of hearing on low tones, slow speech, stuttering, poor coordination, difficulty in swallowing, difficulty in breathing, high blood pressure, liver problems, unusual liver enzyme profiles, I suffer from abdominal cramps and pains, irritable bowel syndrome, [inaudible 01:12:19] bleeding which can last anything up to three or four weeks at a time; frequency of metrition, passing water, severe cramps, pains in the muscles, in the joints; fatigue, chronic fatigue, you just curl up in a ball and you just can't do anything. Yeah. My name is Ray Bristo, former warrant officer with the medical corp with [inaudible 01:13:14]. Also previously served with a bomb unit and special forces.

Speaker 11:

All vaccines injure the immune system. The point is for your immune system to fight back and go after the antigen with an antibody. Each immune system is unique and responds differently to the same vaccine. According to the latest theory of herd immunity, 95 percent of the community must be vaccinated to prevent disease. Think of your immune system as a bull, now imagine that the matador is a vaccine. You'll see that there are three possible outcomes to vaccination. The first it nothing, no immunity and no real harm either. The second possible outcome is that the immune system creates antibodies that go after the antigen. It wins the fight and there is a lifetime of immunity. The third possibility is that the vaccine seriously injures the immune system. It can even result in death.

Russell Dingle:

My name is Major Russell Dingle, former flight commander at 810, instructor pilot at the Connecticut International Guard. I was forced out of the Guard based on my refusal to take the Anthrax vaccine. I could not ask any of my men to do something that I was not willing to do and I was not willing to take the vaccine based on my belief that the order was illegal and immoral.

Speaker 46:

We're trying to change their minds and if they won't change their mind and it won't take the shot then it leads to some kind of disciplinary action.

Russell Dingle:

I was sentenced to 60 days in the brig, convicted on January 12. One year exactly to the day I refused the shot.

Speaker 47:

It's the indignity of being a lab right, of being thought so little of. The fact that I was Lieutenant Colonel and board certified internest and all this other business. I mean, aside from that, the fact that someone thought so little of me to experiment on me like that ...

Speaker 48:

That our law makers in this country say that this is an experimental drug and our soldiers are required to have informed consent and you're not giving it to them.

Speaker 47:

I would find all the people all the way up the chain of command who were responsible for giving me the shot that day and all the other people and I would bring them to task.

Speaker 48:

This is breaking a law. This is no different than doing anything else illegal.

Speaker 49:

Were they not vaccinated and exposed to this agent they would die a horrible death.

Speaker 50:

It was fall in line, get with the program, start marching, and if anybody doesn't march like the Bataan Death March, you just drag them off to the side and shoot them for 32 years. Vietnam, Gulf War, Renata, Panama, and all the little deals in

between. The chain of command has violated the trust that the troops had for them.

Speaker 48:

The commander called the people into the theater and he said, "I want to hear from you folks." One by one they stood up and told their story.

Felix Greeter:

It came to my attention that some of our crew members were having serious, adverse affects from the vaccination program. 15 minutes ago I made the decision that no one at Dover Air Force Base will receive the Anthrax. That Wednesday morning, May fifth of 1999, I thought it was important to make that decision. I am Felix Greeter, a Air Force Colonel. I became a Wing Commander at Dover of the 436 Airlift Wing in 1997. I had 6,000 men and women under my command. I knew that my decision on that Wednesday morning, May fifth, 1999, was the right decision. All of my military training starting from my days at the Air Force Academy as a cadet up through flying training, up through the Navy command at Staff College or War College and the Air Force core values told me that taking care of the people is most important and the people will take care of the mission.

In this case I could see that some of my people were suffering. They needed support. They needed the loyalty from their commander and it was my opportunity in that moment in time to give that to them. I was informed that Lieutenant General Roadman would come personally to Dover Air Force Base along with some additional medical officers to explain the Anthrax vaccination program more fully.

Speaker 50:

For the kick off of a war I haven't seen that many stars show up. The Air Force sent this gigantic rank laden team to Dover.

General Roadman: Dr. Lee Rogers, stand up, Dr. Alvin, Dr. Dana Bradshaw in preventative medicine; Dr. Friedlander from [inaudible 01:18:47]; Colonel Fred Gerber, Colonel Krauter, Army Krauter; Lieutenant Colonel [inaudible 01:18:53] from the Joint

Program Office; Dr. Pittman from [inaudible 01:18:57], Colonel Williams. Because there is the, at least loose connection, in people's mind with the alleged Persian Gulf illness

Speaker 50:

It was every high roller in the Anthrax vaccine program was there to talk to us because the active duty wing commander called a time out.

Speaker 53:

It has been described as crude and dated medical technology.

Felix Greeter:

We would possibly be vulnerable to an Anthrax attach and we had a obligation to protect our troops. I believe that what you are saying is a huge amount of concern to address this issue. The timeout that I called last Wednesday was to address concerns.

Speaker 50:

I'd like to have an answer why I have anti squalene antibodies in my system. There's medical research that's been around for 30 years that indicates this is unsafe, this is very harmful to people, it's oil based agitant. It's a big no-no to use on people. Why did the FDA find this in five Anthrax vaccine lots.

Speaker 53:

Those being ordered to take the vaccine face a profoundly personal choice. If there is no squalene in the Anthrax then I want to know. I want to only know not just from the military but I want to know from people that are saying that there's possibly squalene in it and I want to know it from credible sources like in Stockholm or National Institute of Health. Due to poor record keeping no large scale research has been conducted. Until I hear that I don't feel confident in ever taking another shot. Whether or not to put something in their bodies they fear may due more harm than good. If I have to get court marshaled to not take another shot I will be court marshaled not to take another shot.

General Roadman: I know that squalene is, in fact, a red herring.

Felix Greeter: When General Roadman said that, it brought us a sense of

relief.

General Roadman: I am not concerned about the safety of this medication.

Speaker 53: After military service the uniform comes off but the Anthrax

vaccine stays with you for life.

members and all those assembled in the briefing room to say

that we at Dover were going to reinstate the vaccination

William Cohen: We have tried to do this to the best of our ability.

Speaker 11: Fuad El-Hibri, now 56 years old, had German citizenship from

his mother. His father, [inaudible 01:25:31] El-Hibri, a

Lebanese businessman, lived in four countries to avoid income tax in any one. After graduate school at Stanford University, Faud went to work in Saudi Arabia for Citibank. He returned to

Citibank in New York in the mid 80s to start a mergers and acquisitions division. During the 1990s, when Margaret

Thatcher was privatizing British assets, El-Hibri gained control

of Porton Downs Anthrax vaccine manufacturing facility.

Emergent BioSolutions, formerly BioPort, maintains the only government contract for the Anthrax vaccine. There were so many FDA inspection reports and citations that the US

government needed to spend tens of millions upon millions of dollars to revamp the manufacturing facility. The FDA ordered BioPort to cease manufacturing the Anthrax vaccine because of 35 major citations. Somehow the Anthrax vaccine was still

manufactured and sold during these years despite the fact that the plant was under renovation and vaccine lots were in quarantine.

It received approval in 1970 to manufacture this product and then for 23 years the FDA never came back around again

. I found out through our own government documents that the US military hired another company called PRI in Maryland to produce the vaccine. This company was not licensed. Abraham El-Hibri and his son Fuad financed privatizing he distribution arm of CAMR through [inaudible 01:27:43] Holdings, their Dutch [inaudible 01:27:44] company, to create Porton International. The principle business was selling and distributing the Anthrax vaccines. Admiral Crowe authorized the licenses to export the materials to produce weaponized Anthrax bacteria to Saddam Hussein in the 1980s. He served as Chairman of the Join Chiefs under Presidents Ronald Reagan and George Bush Senior.

Admiral Crowe:

My first experience of a press conference in the state department.

Speaker 20:

In 1994, retired Admiral Crowe was the first senior officer to endorse Clinton's presidential run despite Bill's lack of military service experience. Clinton appointed Admiral Crowe the

ambassador to the United Kingdom. While in England, Ambassador Crowe met Fuad El-Hibri.

Speaker 63:

I do some, what I believe, is important work for national security here in the United Stated.

Speaker 20:

In December of 1995, Republican Governor John Hinkler, with no input from the asset management committee of the state of Michigan, signed an executive order removing the vaccine production unit to Michigan Biological Products Institute. This created a nonprofit entity paving the way for the commercial sales of a state asset. In 1996, Fuad El-Hibri contacted Robert Myers to discuss purchasing the lab as a then German citizen, Fuad El-Hibri was ineligible. In early 1998, SmithKline Beecham retracted a 50 million dollar offer because of the adverse publicity about the Anthrax vaccine.

Speaker 11:

Fuad El-Hibri made Admiral Crowe a partner to eliminate legal issues that would prevent his purchase of BioPort labs, later renamed Emergent BioSolutions. BioPort was purchased for only 25 million dollars and all improvements were paid for by the American tax payers.

Speaker 20:

For retried Admiral Crowe's assistance he received 23 percent of Intervac LLC. This gave Crowe 12.5 percent of the newly formed BioPort, which Fuad controlled.

Speaker 11:

Myers and his assistants appraised the facility at 60 percent of it's value and approved a low down interest free loan for the buyer. In return for their generosity, they received 32 percent of the former asset of the state of Michigan.

Speaker 20:

Fuad El-Hibri now has a monopoly on the free world supply of the Anthrax vaccine. When the deal closed the price per shot increased from three dollars per shot to ten dollars and 64 cents.

Speaker 11:

The Obama administration increased the Anthrax vaccine allowance by adding hundreds of millions of dollars in 2012.

Speaker 50:

Ironically, the very first time I heard the word Anthrax the vaccine or heard about the initiation of the Anthrax vaccine program I was actually deployed over to Kuwait after four years in the Air Force Academy, included seven years of flying F16s, followed by a few years of flying the 810, and then a couple more years of flying the F117, and then I went back to the 810 until the Anthrax vaccine program ended my flying.

Myself, I did not want to receive the vaccine and I did not want to put the Air Force in a compromising position by having a physician come out against the vaccine, so I refused the Article 15. You know, am I going to be alive two years from now or am I going to join the ranks of some of my buddies that are passing away, or in wheelchairs, or walking on crutches; friendly fire. Friendly fire through a needle.

Lt. Rich:

I don't think you can press upon anybody with enough emotion or sincerity about how this can drastically alter your life.

Ken Alibek:

My name is Ken Alibek. In the former Soviet Union, work in the field of [inaudible 01:32:22] developing biological weapons. Being a physician, of course, you do realize it's not something you're suppose to do. You understand that [inaudible

01:32:30] is very essential to protect against United States because at that time I strongly believed it was a case that the United States was researching and developing biological weapons to attack the Soviet Union.

There was nothing wrong with the work to develop biological weapons, because biological weapons ... Some people say they're more humane than other weapons. One of the first forms of Anthrax developed was antibiotic resistant Anthrax. Anthrax which would be very difficult to treat by a big number of antibiotics. Anthrax was considered incurable and when something like this is incurable, especially inhalation Anthrax, of course it makes this pathogen very attractive and very effective weapon.

Lynn Schroeder: Think of how many people can be killed by just a tiny bit of

Anthrax.

Felix Greeter: From 1900 until 2001 there have been only 18 fatalities from

inhalation access.

Speaker 20: Scott Miller, the director of this film, enlisted H. Ross Perot's

help in putting [inaudible 01:33:42] Anthrax vaccine program on Karl Rove's problem agenda in 2001. Rove emailed Paul Wolfowitz and after a defense department review in August 2001, they recommended that the joint chiefs considered cancelling BioPort's Anthrax vaccine program. The very next

month 9/11 happened.

Peter Jennings: We have here with us a man who should know whether or not

it's working. Jerry Hauer, who's the former head of New York

City mayor's office of emergency management.

Speaker 11: Jerome Hauer told Peter Jennings that the twin tower attack

was not the work of a foreign government. He mentioned

Osama Bin Laden's name.

Speaker 11: Jerome Hauer was also managing director of Kroll Associtates,

an international risk management firm serving clients in the US government, and the military, and also the national security advisor with the national institute of health. Seven days after the 9/11 attacks, five Anthrax dusted letters arrived by post killing five people in New York and Florida. Jerome Hauer knew that there would be an Anthrax attack. He advised certain

members of the White House cabinet to start taking Cipro one week before the first Anthrax letter arrived at the post office.

Speaker 68: Anthrax reported at a Florida hospital. One Florida man is in

the hospital.

Speaker 69: Is hospitalized with inhalation Anthrax.

Speaker 11: Seven days after the 9/11 attacks, five Anthrax dusted letters

arrived by post killing five people in New York and Florida. Tens of thousands of Americans were given the antibiotic Cipro and

a massive FBI investigation was set in motion.

Speaker 70: Anthrax scare has now reached Capitol Hill.

George W. Bush: I just talked to leader Daschle. His office received a letter and it

had Anthrax in it.

Speaker 71: It arrived at Senator Daschle's office on Friday and was opened

and handled by an intern this morning.

Speaker 11:

Emergent BioSolutions disgraced Anthrax vaccine program was given a new lease on life. Production went into high gear using experimental [inaudible 01:36:37] to stretch the available doses of vaccines.

Speaker 20:

Dr. Bruce Ivans was an Army career scientist who worked exclusively with Anthrax since 1979. During the 1990s he authorized the addition of MF59 squalene into secret batches of vaccine to boost an immune response. The FDA directed Dr. Ivans to test every lot of APA vaccine created before the year 2000. All of them proved to be completely unreliable against Anthrax and many of the animals died. In July of 2008 an increasingly despondent Dr. Ivans commits suicide.

Speaker 72: He killed himself before we could get to him.

Speaker 73: Where is the smoking gun? Where is the proof?

Speaker 74: If Dr. Ivans wasn't the perpetrator, that person is still out there.

Speaker 11:

Ivans' guilt or innocent and whether the spores came from [inaudible 01:37:31] in Utah or Fort Detrick in Maryland isn't as important to the average American as the FBI's admission that this was an inside job. The real question is how big is the inner circle from which that insider acted? The Anthrax threat restarted the Anthrax vaccine program with a vengeance. It saved Bayer, the maker of Cipro, from the brink of bankruptcy.

It created the need for new security systems and surveillance, provided the alibi for war on terror in Afghanistan and Iraq, and the list goes on and on until it gets to American civil liberties. Congress passed the Patriot Act because of the fear generated by 9/11 and the Anthrax letter attacks. The go to guy on the Anthrax threat, Russian defector, Colonel Ken Alibek, insisted that vaccines were ineffective against munitions grade Anthrax.

13 congressional hearings arrived at the same conclusion. The DoD was not capable of adequately moderation the Anthrax vaccine program. When cornered, Assistant Secretary of Defense for health affairs, Dr. Winkenwerder, admitted that there was no evidence of an increased threat of Anthrax to our troops.

Speaker 75:

We have a very safe history with vaccines and we have a very safe history with Anthrax vaccine.

Speaker 11:

This boast appears on their website: "Our principles lead and managed the Defense Department, the largest and most complex enterprise in the world." Mr. El-Hibri must be referring to his team of lobbyists, lead by the man who instigated the mandatory Anthrax program in 1998, former Secretary of Defense, William Cohen. The Cohen Group is helping develop international markets for Emergent BioSolutions Anthrax vaccine. BioPort began a campaign urging law makers to initiate nationwide immunization of civilians.

Ken Alibek:

The biggest interest is for Al-Qaeda and for some other terrorist groups. They already have biological weapons developed, [inaudible 01:40:53], and ready for use and this is just to bring this biological agents and weapons into the United States. Anthrax, in my opinion, is still one of the biggest threats. At the same time I cannot say that this vaccine is safe. There are no safe vaccines at all.

Sunny Bates:

If I can convince a commander that there's an issue that they would fix it and I believed that. I went to headquarters, talked to General Starbuck, he treated me very well. When soil bacteria gets into a snakes saliva glands it ferments into venom. APA, an [inaudible 01:42:49] just like snake venom, is the key ingredient in all Anthrax vaccines. It is the slim that Anthrax secretes to protect itself. It is very clever and can commandeer cell proteins for it's own purposes. Squalene, a fat compound that synthesizes hormones, cholesterol and vitamin D, was added to the Anthrax vaccine to make tiny APA more visible. Unfortunately, together they appear to be a cell with cell proteins bound to it.

APA is able to signal furine to activate it. Think of furine as a scissor. It activates growth factors by cutting a critical protein that starts a chain reaction. Macrophage means big eater. Y-shaped memory B cells attach to the cell wall and catch antigens for the macrophage to eat but Anthrax protected antigen is smaller and able to out maneuver the B cells. Squalene aligned APA signals the enzyme creating, furine, to cut off it's top.

Seven APAs for a normal cell pore landing pad capable of receiving signal proteins. This Trojan horse is full of it's own agents. APA sends in the Anthrax edema factor first. It bills a cyclic AMP factor that coverts fat to starch and then into sugar water. APA takes over the docking sites and gets to work to protect Anthrax, not you. APA releases two Anthrax lethal factor proteins.

They trigger a normal, but fatal demolition process. Once the cell wall collapses, the Anthrax bacteria can feed and multiply. APA is made of the [inaudible 01:44:27] of glutamic acid instead of the L form of amino acids found in proteins and if passing t-cells recognize that furine is involved in an illegal activity with an antigen, they will make antibodies to furin because they can't make antibodies to APA.

Furin activates nerve growth factor. Deprived of nerve growth factor, severe depression and schizophrenia can occur. Furin activates transforming growth factor beta 1. Without this, rheumatoid arthritis, tendinitis, tendon rupture, giant cell arteritis, and [inaudible 01:45:03] arteritis would result. Without furin to activate parathyroid hormone your body would develop chronic fatigue syndrome. Furin activates beta [inaudible 01:45:13] and Gonadotropin. Without either hormone, glands like the prostate, scrotum, breast, and ovaries will malfunction resulting in burning semen syndrome and cysts.

Without furin to activate [inaudible 01:45:27], chronic skin, hair, tear gland, salvia gland problems would develop. Furin activates affect your t-cells to produce tumor necrosis factor alpha 1, essential to the rapid response component of the immune system which prevents metastatic cancers. Furin is required to activate suppressor t-cells. Without suppressor t-cells, anti nuclear antibodies will not be controlled leading to auto immune diseases of healthy tissues. When the Anthrax vaccine causes furin sequestering antibodies. It can lead to all of the Gulf War Syndrome diseases and Gulf war neurological illness as well as birth defects.

In the summer of 2012, the Obama administration allocated one point two billion dollars for trials of the Anthrax vaccine on two year old children and the elderly. The fact was that antibiotics proved to be successful in treating weapons grade inhalation Anthrax. Inexpensive doxycycline is now the recommended drug of choice because of the side effects due to Cipro.
